Strength Recovery from Nonsurgical Treatment of Apophyseal Avulsions of the Pelvis

Strength deficits, strength recovery, and return to sports timing following nonoperative apophyseal avulsion fractures are relatively unknown, as is the effect of displacement of the avulsed fragment. This study aims to assess strength recovery following a pelvic apophyseal avulsion and determine whether a relationship between radiographic characteristics and strength exists.



The American Orthopaedic Society of Sports Medicine held its annual meeting on July 10-12 in Nashville, TN. UT Southwestern Orthopaedic Surgery Assistant Professor and Scottish Rite Faculty Member, Jacob C. Jones, M.D., RMSK took center stage to present during the meeting.

Dr. Jones shared new findings demonstrating early changes in elbow cartilage among young, healthy gymnasts using ultrasound. This research may support earlier detection of elbow conditions allowing for timely intervention and potential reducing time away from the sport.

Also in attendance during the meeting was Scottish Rite and UT Southwestern Orthopaedic Surgery faculty members, **Philip Wilson**, **M.D.**, and **Henry Ellis**, **M.D.**, who each presented their research and led instructional course lectures.



UT Southwestern Orthopaedic Surgery faculty featured in new Musculoskeletal Pain book



The Impact of Age on Outcomes Following Secondary Reconstructive Surgery for Residual Dysplasia in DDH

After reduction of developmental hip dislocations, residual dysplasia is common with rates of secondary reconstructive surgery with pelvic osteotomy ranging from 19% to 60%. The determination and timing of when to proceed with surgery is difficult as acetabular remodeling occurs gradually over the first few years after reduction ...
