

Continuous Adductor Canal Block Compared to Epidural Anesthesia for Total Knee Arthroplasty - Journal of Pain Research

PGY 3 Resident, **Harold Gregory Moore**, **M.D.**, was an author on this most recent study featured in the **Journal of Pain Research**. The study aims to compare the efficacy of a postoperative continuous adductor canal block (cACB) with and without a steroid adjuvant to that of epidural

analgesia for total knee arthroplasty.


